Question: How do you know when you have felt God?

If you don't always feel God's presence, you are not alone.

Psalm 88:13-14
<sup>13</sup> But I cry to you for help, Lord; in the morning my prayer comes before you.
<sup>14</sup> Why, Lord, do you reject me and hide your face from me?

But go to Him when your need is desperate, when all other help is vain, and what do you find? A door slammed in your face, and a sound of bolting and double bolting on the inside. After that, silence. – C.S. Lewis *A Grief Observed* 

You may as well turn away. The longer you wait, the more emphatic the silence will be come. There are no lights in the windows. It might be an empty house. Was it ever inhabited? It seemed so once. And that seeming was as strong as this. What can this mean? Why is He so present a commander in our time of prosperity and so very absent a help in time of trouble? – C.S. Lewis *A Grief Observed* 

#### Reasons we may not feel God.

## 1) Maybe I over sensationalize it

John 6:30

<sup>30</sup> So they asked him, "What sign then will you give that we may see it and believe you? What will you do?

<sup>31</sup> Our ancestors ate the manna in the wilderness; as it is written: 'He gave them bread from heaven to eat.

## 2) Maybe my heart has hardened.

Matthew 13:13-15

<sup>13</sup> This is why I speak to them in parables:

"Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand. <sup>14</sup> In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah:

"You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving.
<sup>15</sup> For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes.
Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them.'

Psalm 51:10-12 <sup>10</sup> Create in me a pure heart, O God,

and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

<sup>11</sup> Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me.

<sup>12</sup> Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

# 3) Maybe God wants to draw me closer

## Acts 17:22-23, 26-27

<sup>22</sup> Paul then stood up in the meeting of the Areopagus (Eh·ree·**aa**·puh·guhs) and said: "People of Athens! I see that in every way you are very religious. <sup>23</sup> For as I walked around and looked carefully at your objects of worship, I even found an altar with this inscription: to an unknown god. So you are ignorant of the very thing you worship—and this is what I am going to proclaim to you.

<sup>26</sup> From one man He made all the nations, that they should inhabit the whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands.

<sup>27</sup> God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us.
