Title: Messed up Genealogy

¹⁶ All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷ so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Question:

If all Scripture is God breathed and useful, and will equip me; how are the genealogies going to do that?

"... the cultural context of scripture is important to interpreting the message. We are admonished 4 times in the NT to greet each other with a "holy kiss". Nor do we demand all persons leading in prayer MUST lift up their hands as instructed in 1st Timothy.

Scripture is written FOR us but not always TO us. In the Epistles especially we are reading a one-sided conversation and have to guess some of the context. This is why along with scripture: we look to the larger church body for consensus, we use our own rational thinking to search out the context, and we look to those around us for a unifying experience."

Rehoboam the father of Abijah,

Abijah the father of Asa,

⁸ Asa the father of Jehoshaphat,

Jehoshaphat the father of Jehoram,

Jehoram the father of Uzziah,

⁹ Uzziah the father of Jotham,

Jotham the father of Ahaz.

Ahaz the father of Hezekiah,

¹⁰ Hezekiah the father of Manasseh,

Manasseh the father of Amon,

Amon the father of Josiah,

¹¹ and Josiah the father of Jeconiah and his brothers at the time of the exile to Babylon.

¹² After the exile to Babylon:

Jeconiah was the father of Shealtiel,

Shealtiel the father of Zerubbabel,

¹³ Zerubbabel the father of Abihud,

Abihud the father of Eliakim,

Eliakim the father of Azor,

¹⁴ Azor the father of Zadok.

Zadok the father of Akim,

Akim the father of Elihud,

¹⁵ Elihud the father of Eleazar,

Eleazar the father of Matthan,

Matthan the father of Jacob.

¹⁶ and Jacob the father of Joseph, the husband of Mary, and Mary was the mother of Jesus who is called the Messiah.

¹⁷ Thus there were fourteen generations in all from Abraham to David, fourteen from David to the exile to Babylon, and fourteen from the exile to the Messiah.

Abraham = LIAR/SELFISH/COWARDLY

Jacob = LIAR/THIEF/MANIPULATOR

Judah = INCEST/ADULTRY/MANIPULATION

Rahab = PROSTITUION

David = RAPE, MURDER, LYING TO GOD'S MESSANGER—NATHAN
