## Working Faith Week 5 7/16/23

#### 1 Peter 2:19-21

<sup>19</sup> For it is commendable if someone bears up under the pain of unjust suffering because they are conscious of God. <sup>20</sup> But how is it to your credit if you receive a beating for doing wrong and endure it? But if you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God. <sup>21</sup> To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps.

#### John 20:19a

<sup>19</sup> On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders...

#### John 20:19b-20

...Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" <sup>20</sup> After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord.

#### What did they do in the 3 days?

- 1) Friday: Fear and Pain.
  - a. Reach out to friends

#### Matthew 26:36-39a

<sup>36</sup> Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to them, "Sit here while I go over there and pray." <sup>37</sup> He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee along with him, and he began to be sorrowful and troubled. <sup>38</sup> Then he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me."

<sup>39</sup> Going a little farther, he fell with his face to the ground and prayed...

<u>Emotions/feelings:</u> You don't repress them; you don't suppress them. You express them and you confess them.

#### Galatians 6:2

<sup>2</sup>Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.

b. Reach out to God

#### Mark 14:35-36

<sup>35</sup> Going a little farther, he fell to the ground and prayed that if possible the hour might pass from him. <sup>36</sup> *"Abba*, Father," he said, "everything is possible for you. Take this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will."

## Matthew 26:31

<sup>31</sup> Then Jesus told them, "This very night you will all fall away on account of me

Mark 14:27

<sup>27</sup>...Jesus told them, "All of you will desert me.

How to get through the days of grief and fear? Remember the promises of God!

## John 16:16, 20-22

<sup>16</sup> Jesus went on to say, "In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me."
<sup>20</sup> Very truly I tell you, you will weep and mourn while the world rejoices. You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy. <sup>21</sup> A woman giving birth to a child has pain because her time has come; but when her baby is born she forgets the anguish because of her joy that a child is born into the world. <sup>22</sup> So with you: Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will rejoice, and no one will take away your joy.

<sup>20</sup> For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.
