Getting to Know Me Questions:

- In YouTube: search "Guess the company slogan quiz" play the first game together (4 mins long)
- Who is the most "famous" person you've met? Tell the story.

Into the Bible Questions:

- What's something from the teaching that you learned, that stood out, interesting etc?
- We talked about the Church mantra/slogan, which is... "Live. Hope." Did you know this was a thing? When you hear it or have heard it, is there anything that comes to mind?
- We talked about the purpose of our Church which says "We exist to demonstrate the Living Hope of Jesus to our community and to our world."
- **READ**: 1 Peter 1:3-4
- How do you define "Hope"? How do you define "Hopeless"? Is one easier than the other?
- The 4 stages of faith/discipleship at Living Hope are...1) Belong 2) Believe 3) Become 4) Behave
- Pastor Kirby said 'everyone has a desire to belong somewhere or with someone, and if you say you don't then it's probably because you're already accepted into it.' Talk about a time you visited or attended a Church in which you felt awkward/not welcome/scared etc? What about that experience made it that way?
- **READ:** Luke 19:1-10
- What sticks out to you as you read this story, either for the first time or again? (Maybe read it again, in a different translation)
- Pastor Kirby said "We (Church People) expect people to act like Jesus when they don't know Jesus yet." (This is a question of behavior). In what ways do we (Church people) do this to guests who come?

Application Questions:

- Pastor Kirby asked "what will people experience when they come to living hope to find Jesus?" How would you answer this? Think of your co-worker, friend, family member and they come for the first time, what do you want them to experience?
- What are some practical things we (LH Church people) can do to show people they can come and just belong?
- In what ways can I (yes, you reading this) be a part of helping people to simply belong?
- How can we "Live Hope" to our community this week?

Mantra: Live. Hope.

BELONG

Luke 19:1-10

¹ Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. ² A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy.

³ He wanted to see who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd. ⁴So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.

⁵When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today." ⁶So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly.

⁷ All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner."
